TIPS FOR FINDING FURNITURE ASSISTANCE

- ACT QUICKLY Furniture assistance programs have limited inventory or waiting lists, so it's important to contact these organizations as soon as possible when you know you'll be moving.
- CHECK ELIGIBILITY Some organizations may have eligibility requirements based on income or family size, so be sure to ask about those details.
- **CONSIDER VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES** Some organizations, like Habitat for Humanity and Goodwill, may offer discounts or furniture for free if you are willing to volunteer.
